It directs the State to provide free legal aid with the aid of suitable legislation (such as the National Legal Services Authority Act) or schemes and ensure that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizen for reason of economic or other disabilities.

Legal Aid is the provision of assistance to people otherwise unable to afford legal representation and access to the court system. The institute's Foundation believes that certain community groups, if sensitized through proper interaction and guidance, can play a crucial role of active agent in the transformation of the society. Programs organized under this project will be towards promoting consciousness among and building capacity of various community groups about legal culture, legal processes, legal resources and effective use of the legal systems.
