Around 45 students along with 3 faculty member had visited the hospital. The visit started at 1.30 pm from the College. We boarded the college bus to reach to Karad. We reached there around 2.45 pm. At the reception, we were welcomed by the team members of Krushna Hospital. The students visited to the different departments of the hospital like ICU, ICCU, IN-Patient Pharmacy, OUT-patient pharmacy, canteen, pathology lab, CATH Lab, operation theatres, emergency services etc. was arranged. A detailed explanation regarding each department was given during the visit. This was followed by a detailed presentation about the role of hospital pharmacy in hospital, drug distribution systems, and inventory management and medication errors. In the end, we visited the In-Patient pharmacy store, where we had to chance the actual storage, purchasing and billing of drugs to patients. We also saw the special precautions for storage of narcotic drugs. Overall, the visit was very informative and enjoyable and helps in enriching the curriculum. We came to know regarding the role of Hospital Pharmacist in the overall health management.

Outcome: - Students learn about the right dose, route of administration, time, drug, information and documentation are respected when any medication is used.
